FREIGHTING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Passengers who so desire may arrange to have their motor vehicles carried by rail between Port Pirie and Parkes-ton (Commonwealth Railways terminal three miles east of Kalgoorlie). They are advised that the carriage of such vehicles is at THE SOLE RISK OF THE OWNER.

Where intending passengers desire their motor vehicles to accompany them, acceptance of orders for such vehicles is subject to passenger bookings first being finalised.

In special circumstances, car bookings may be accepted less than seven days in advance.

Passengers' motor vehicles are conveyed by the following trains :—

Westbound.—In the westbound direction passengers' motor vehicles are conveyed on goods trains which depart Port Pirie shortly after the passenger train. They are available for delivery at Parkes-ton at 9.30 a.m. on the morning after the passenger arrives.

Transport will be provided between Kalgoorlie and Parkes-ton for the drivers only taking delivery of their motor vehicles at Parkes-ton.

Eastbound.—In the eastbound direction, passengers' motor vehicles are carried on goods trains which depart Parkes-ton on the afternoon of the day prior to departure of the passenger train. They are available for delivery at Port Pirie shortly after arrival of the passenger train at that location.

Transport will be provided between Parkes-ton and Kalgoorlie for drivers only loading their motor vehicles at Parkes-ton.

Loading Times

Westbound

Port Pirie (on day of travel) 2.00 p.m.—3.00 p.m.

Eastbound

Parkes-ton (on day prior to day of travel) 2.00 p.m.—3.00 p.m.

FREIGHT RATES ON MOTOR VEHICLES

A concession in freight rates is allowed on motor cars, utilities, panel vans and station wagons, provided that the equivalent of two adult first-class or three adult second-class fares is paid for the same journey as the motor vehicle.

Single freight rates on motor vehicles between Port Pirie and Parkes-ton are :—

BOOKING OF RAIL ACCOMMODATION

Rail accommodation for forward journeys to and from Western Australia may be booked twelve calendar months in advance.

Return rail accommodation may be booked by passengers purchasing return tickets, up to thirteen calendar months in advance.

Passenger bookings may be completed at Railways Interstate Booking Offices or Tourist Bureaux.

LUGGAGE

Free Allowance

Passengers undertaking through journeys over the Trans-Australian Railway (or between Port Augusta and Kalgoorlie)—

1st Class	168 lb.
2nd Class	112 lb.

Luggage Checks

Passengers may "check" their luggage between any of the places at which inter-system rail tickets are on issue.

As the space available for luggage in sleeping compartments is necessarily limited, passengers are recommended to take with them in the compartment one suitcase not exceeding 28 inches in length which can be placed in the rack provided for this purpose and one smaller case (say 14-16 inches).

Other luggage should be "checked through" in the brakevan.
